Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Gloucester County Utilities Authority (GCUA) on **Thursday, May 3, 2018 at 11:00 a.m.**, prevailing time at the GCUA Administrative Office, located at 2 Paradise Road, West Deptford, New Jersey 08066, at which time and place bids will be opened and ready in public for:

**2018 ANNUAL SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE SUPPLY
CONTRACT NO. 2018-Sodium Hypochlorite**

The project principally consists of furnishing and delivering approximately 350,000 gallons of sodium hypochlorite to the GCUA.

The bid must be accompanied by a Non-Collusion Affidavit. Public Disclosure, Chapter 33 of the Public Laws of 1977 provides that no corporation or partnership shall be awarded any State, County, Municipal or School District contract for the performance of any work or the furnishing of any materials or supplies, unless, prior to the receipt of the bid or accompanying the bid of said corporation or partnership there is submitted a statement. The statement shall set forth the names and addresses of all stockholders in the corporation or partnership who own 10% or more of its stock or any class, or of all individual partners in the partnership who own a 10% or greater interest. **FAILURE TO SUPPLY THIS INFORMATION WITH YOUR FORM OF PROPOSAL WILL BE CAUSE TO REJECT THE BID.** The GCUA reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informality in the proposal received and to accept the bid which in their judgment will best serve the interests of the GCUA. Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A.10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27 laws against discrimination because of race, religion, sex, color, etc.
