**RESOLUTION OF THE GLOUCESTER COUNTY UTILITIES
AUTHORITY AMENDING RESOLUTION 2021-106 AUTHORIZING THE
EMERGENCY REPAIR OF THE GRIT BUILDING BY-PASS PIPING**

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2021, the Board of Commissioners of the Gloucester County Utilities Authority Approved Resolution 2021-106 authorizing the emergency repair of the Grit Building By-Pass Piping in accordance with the GCUA Engineer's certification of October 7, 2021, and

WHEREAS, on February 7, 2022, the GCUA Engineer further certified that the amount of the emergency repair approved by the GCUA in the amount of \$15,810 was a quoted price and that additional work was required to install a 6" line stop to prevent the sludge from flowing back from the Grit Building and the additional work totaled \$6,570; and

WHEREAS, the GCUA Engineer's February 7, 2022, written letter opinion certifying this additional cost for the emergency contract to Pioneer Pipe Contractors, Inc., for an additional \$6,570 increasing the total not to exceed amount to \$22,380.00, the Engineer's opinion is incorporated herein and made a part hereof this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners on this 9th day of March 2022, that it hereby amends Resolution 2021-106 authorizing the emergency repair of the grit building by-pass piping as outlined above and in the GCUA Engineer's October 7, 2021 and February 7, 2022, certifications of emergent repair to Pioneer Pipe Contractors, Inc., in the amended total amount of \$22,380.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Director and staff are directed to take all necessary steps and measures to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.



WHEREAS, an application has been submitted by the Borough of Woodbury Heights for an NJDEP Treatment Works Approval for a project known as Candidus Avenue Pump Station Rehabilitation, with an allocation of 0 GPD, consisting of an existing pump station flow 36,300 GPD and no new flow is to be added replacing a two pump – pump station; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications for this project have been reviewed by the staff of the Gloucester County Utilities Authority and have been found to be proper; and

WHEREAS, this project is subject to the payment of the Authority's Sanitary Sewerage Connection fees, said fees to be paid at a later date when application is made for an allocation of capacity for this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners on this 9th day of March 2022, that it hereby endorses the above application for an NJDEP Treatment Works Approval for the project known as Candidus Avenue Pump Station Rehabilitation, with an allocation of 0 GPD, consisting of an existing pump station flow 36,300 GPD and no new flow is to be added replacing a two pump – pump station.

WHEREAS, the Gloucester County Utilities Authority determined that the bid proposal of **Polydyne, Inc.**, in the amount of \$2.65 per pound is compliant in all material, non-waivable respects and is therefore deemed the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director has certified that sufficient funds are available for the purposes of the bid specification and that such funds have been appropriated for the budget year; and

WHEREAS, the award of the bid in the manner set forth above is necessary for the efficient operation of the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Authority as follows:

1. **Polydyne Inc., One Chemical Plant Road, Riceboro, GA 31323** is determined to be the lowest responsive bidder for the **2022 Biennial Dry Polymer Supply**.





AWARDING CONTRACT TO JUPITER CONTRACTING PCC, INC. FOR SLUDGE
PROCESSING BUILDING (DRY END BUILDING) SLUDGE CONVEYOR
INSTALLATION**

WHEREAS, the Gloucester County Utilities Authority (“Authority”) solicited proposals for the Sludge Conveyor Installation at the Sludge Processing Building (Dry End Building) as follows:

WHEREAS, *N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(gg)* provides for an exception to the public bidding requirement for the construction, operation and maintenance of wastewater treatment facilities:

40A:11-5 Exceptions. Any contract the amount of which exceeds the bid Threshold, may be negotiated and awarded by the governing body without public advertising for bids and bidding therefor and shall be awarded by Resolution of the governing body if:

(1) The subject matter thereof consists of:

(gg) A contract for the provision of water supply services or wastewater treatment services entered into pursuant to section 2 of P.L.2002, c.47 (C.40A:11-5.1), or the designing, financing, construction, operation, or maintenance, or any combination thereof, of a water supply facility as defined in subsection (16) of section 15 of P.L.1971, c.198 (C.40A:11-15) or a wastewater treatment system as defined in subsection (19) of section 15 of P.L.1971, c.198 (C.40A:11-15), or any component part or parts thereof, including a water filtration system as defined in subsection (16) of section 15 of P.L.1971, c.198 (C.40A:11-15).

WHEREAS, the Sludge Processing Building (Dry End Building) is a critical part of the GCUA Wastewater Treatment system and water filtration system; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq.* the Authority's Engineer reviewed the only proposal submitted and recommends award to the lowest responsible proposer, Jupiter Contracting PCC, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Gloucester County Utilities Authority determined that the proposal of Jupiter Contracting PCC, Inc., in the amount of \$98,070.00, is the lowest responsive proposal and is compliant in all material, non-waivable respects; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director has certified the availability of funds for such contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Gloucester County Utilities Authority of the County of Gloucester, New Jersey, that the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the execution of a contract with Jupiter Contracting PCC, Inc. for the Sludge Conveyor Installation at the Sludge Processing Building (Dry End Building) in the amount of \$98,070.00 and appropriates an additional amount of \$21,930.00 to cover contingencies, if any, for a total authorization/appropriation of \$120,000.00 exclusive of any permissible change orders.


