**RESOLUTION OF THE GLOUCESTER COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY  
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE FROM VERIZON CONNECT NWF, INC.  
THROUGH THE SOURCEWELL NATIONAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING  
SYSTEM CONTRACT #020221-NWF**

**WHEREAS**, the Gloucester County Utilities Authority (“Authority”) has a need to purchase a vehicle tracking subscription; and

**WHEREAS**, *N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2*, as amended by P.L. 2011, c.139, authorizes the Authority to purchase goods or to contract for services through the use of a recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing system that has been developed utilizing a competitive bidding process by another contracting unit within the State of New Jersey, or within any other state, when available; and

**WHEREAS**, the State recognized Sourcewell is a cooperative purchasing program for the purchase of goods and services from Sourcewell vendors; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority wishes to purchase from Verizon Connect NWF, Inc. of 512 Township Line Road, 2 Valley Square, Blue Bell, PA 19422 through the Sourcewell National Cooperative Pricing System, number 020221-NWF at \$17.45 per unit, per month as needed; and

**WHEREAS**, purchases through Sourcewell comply with the Local Public Contracts Law requirements; and


**WHEREAS**, the Executive Director has certified that sufficient funds are available for the purpose of purchasing the monthly subscription and that such funds have been appropriated for the budget year.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Gloucester County Utilities Authority on this 10<sup>th</sup> day of January 2024 that the Executive Director is hereby authorized to

award a contract and execute any and all documents at his discretion to effectuate the purpose of purchasing a vehicle tracking subscription from Verizon Connect NWF, Inc. at the rate of \$17.45 per month on an as needed basis from January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2025, with an option to extend for one (1) year.

**WHEREAS**, an application has been submitted by the Township of East Greenwich for an NJDEP Treatment Works Approval for a project known as Creekside Crossing with an allocation of 32,400 GPD, consisting of 108 Townhomes; and

**WHEREAS**, plans and specifications for this project have been reviewed by the staff of the Gloucester County Utilities Authority and have been found to be proper; and

**WHEREAS**, this project is subject to the payment of the Authority's Sanitary Sewerage Connection fees, said fees to be paid at a later date when application is made for an allocation of capacity for this project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners on this 10<sup>th</sup> day of January 2024, that it hereby endorses the above application for an NJDEP Treatment Works Approval for the project known as Creekside Crossing, with an allocation of 32,400 GPD, consisting of 108 Townhomes.



**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-024**

**RESOLUTION OF THE GLOUCESTER COUNTY UTILITIES  
AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE EMERGENCY REPAIR  
OF THE SEWER FORCE MAIN ON THE MONROE BIKE PATH**

**WHEREAS**, the GCUA owns a 14" DIP force main which services various pump stations in Monroe Township and conveys wastewater to the Upper Mantua Creek Interceptor;

**WHEREAS**, corrosion of the pipe resulted in a pipe failure near Skyles Avenue on January 2, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, environmental regulations require immediate response to sewer infrastructure failure to protect public safety as raw sewage or an untreated wastewater spill creates health, safety and welfare hazards in addition to environmental concerns; and

**WHEREAS**, several leaks were located, and an emergency repair was completed by Pioneer Pipe Contractors, Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, the GCUA Engineer has certified in a January 4, 2024, letter to the GCUA that the emergency repair to Sewer Force Main on the Monroe Bike Path was necessary for compliance and safety to the public; an emergency contract was awarded in accordance with the procedures for emergency contracts as promulgated and contained in *N.J.A.C. 5:34-6.1, et seq.* and *N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq.*; and

**WHEREAS**, the GCUA Engineer has certified and confirmed that the emergency repair was a one-time event to address the immediate need to place the system back into service, to restore access to residential properties and to restore the bike path; and

**WHEREAS**, the GCUA Engineer's January 4, 2024, written letter opinion certifying this as an emergency contract and recommended payment for the emergency repairs to Pioneer Pipe Contractors, Inc., in a total amount not to exceed \$40,000.00, the Engineer's opinion is incorporated herein and made a part hereof this resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners on this 10<sup>th</sup> day of January 2024, that it hereby authorizes the payment for the emergency repair of the Sewer Force Main on the Monroe Bike Path as outlined above and in the GCUA Engineer's January 4, 2024, certification of emergent repair to Pioneer Pipe Contractors, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$40,000.00.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Executive Director and staff are directed to take all necessary steps and measures to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.
